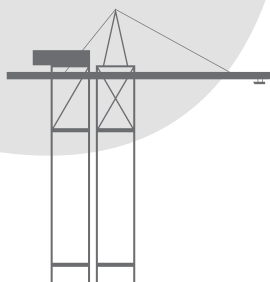

Amid a cost-of-living crisis, the dockers at the Port of Felixstowe have been given a pay cut.

Meanwhile, their mega-rich employers have doled out £100 million to shareholders.

So the dockers are taking strike action to demand a real wage rise to help them cope with soaring living costs.

The Port of Felixstowe is fabulously wealthy, banking pre-tax profits of £61m in 2020.

It can easily afford to raise wages.

Strike action is a last resort for our members. They would much rather be getting on with their jobs.

The Port of Felixstowe is Britain's largest and busiest container port. The strike will cause massive disruption to the UK supply chain. But what choice do they have?

The company has the money to pay a fair wage. It's up to them to sort this out.
