Unite general secretary, Sharon Graham said: **"Over the last 12 months Unite has delivered at the workplace winning over £200 million for members in dispute. As promised in my manifesto Unite will now use that power to do the same within our communities."**

A new national Survation poll commissioned by Unite reports that incomes are being stretched due to cost of living pressures, 70% of those polled nationally said their income has not increased at all in line with the rise in price of goods and services. Over 23% of constituents in Barrow have either gone into debt or have increased levels of debt just to buy groceries while big retailers continue to make excessive profits.
